



# CR MARINE MOORING SNUBBER INSTRUCTIONS



## Instructions

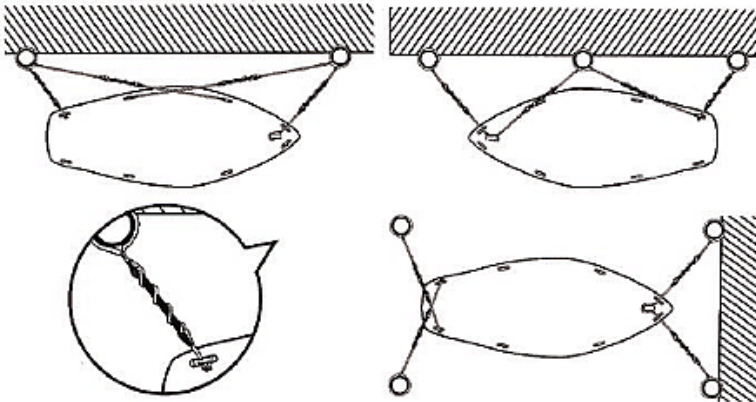
1. Determine location of snubber on the line
2. Thread line through holes as indicated. Wrap 1 (calm) to 3 (extreme) turns depending on tidal and wave conditions. **DO NOT WRAP MORE THAN 3 TIMES**, as this could strain the snubber and shorten its useful life.
3. Double check snubber placement and that lines have been threaded properly. Pull hard on the line to force it securely down between locking elements.



NOTE: It is recommended to have a snubber on every line.  
For use with high-stretch dock lines only
